Policy 503: Student Attendance

The purpose of this policy is to encourage regular school attendance. It is intended to be positive and not punitive.

(Updates excused absences. 6/2025 MSBA update)

*Policy 506: Student Discipline

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that students are aware of and comply with the school district's expectations for student conduct.

(Adds unscheduled student removal provision and updated info about restraints. 6/2024 MSBA update)

Policy 507: Corporal Punishment and Prone Restraint

District's last update: October 2023 The purpose of this policy is to describe limitations on corporal punishment and prone restraints. (Adds reasonable force language and corrects legal references. 6/2024 MSBA update)

Policy 509: Enrollment of NonResident Students

The purpose of this policy is to set forth the application and exclusion procedures used by the school district in making said determination.

(Removes School Readiness Plus and adds School of Parents' Choice Law. 6/2024 MSBA update)

Policy 512: School-sponsored Student Publications and Activities

The purpose of this policy is to protect students' rights to free speech in production of school-sponsored media and activities while at the same time balancing the school district's role in supervising student publications and operation of public schools.

(New terminology: "school-sponsored media", Adds student journalism law. 2/25 MSBA update)

Policy 514: Bullying Prohibition Policy

District's last update: December 2022 The purpose of this policy is to assist the school district in its goal of preventing and responding to acts of bullying, intimidation, violence, reprisal, retaliation, and other similar disruptive and detrimental behavior. The purpose of this policy is to provide direction for continuous review and improvement of the school curriculum.

Policy 624: Online Instruction

District's last update: November 2023

The purpose of this policy is to provide adequate opportunity for students identified as having individualized education program (IEP), Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Section 504 accommodation plan (504 plan), or English Learner (EL) needs to participate in statewide assessment systems designed to hold schools accountable for the academic performance of all students.
