From September 2017 to 2018 there were 897 participants in community education sponsored classes and events. Additionally, 309 students participated in summer recreation programs. Open gym at the Al Siegle Activity Center ranged in nightly average attendance from 60 to 80 people in December through March. 15 to 25 people per night in April through July.
