Recommendation: Set the rate for mileage and meal reimbursement. The current mileage rate for personnel using their personal vehicle for school business when a school-owned vehicle is not available is the current IRS rate or .20 per mile when a school-owned vehicle is available and declined by the employee. The meal reimbursement rate for district staff when attending approved events by administration, including a reasonable gratuity, is \$15 for breakfast, \$15 for lunch, and \$25 for supper. This legislation provides the reimbursement for a free breakfast and lunch to students who receive meals through their school's participation in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and the School Breakfast Program (SBP). Schools that participate in the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) National School Lunch Program (NSLP) must now participate in the state funded Free School Meals Program.
