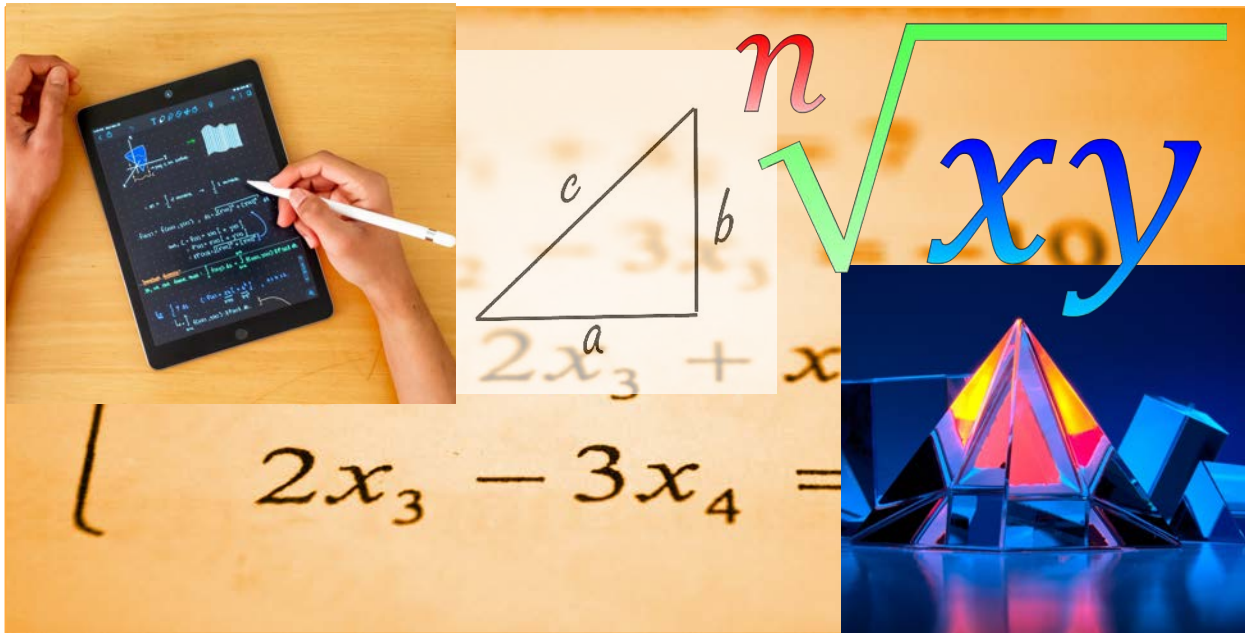




Foundations of College Math

This 10-week course aims to prepare students for success in post-secondary introductory math courses. The first five weeks are devoted to algebra foundations, and the second half focuses on probability, statistics, and geometry concepts. Throughout the course, students also have an opportunity to develop and strengthen the critical reading skills necessary for solving application word problems often encountered in course assessments.
