## ***ALL OBLIGATIONS MUST BE CLEARED BEFORE RECEIVING A CAP & GOWN***

1. Caps and gowns are used every year and may be dusty or wrinkled.
2. Gowns should **NOT** be washed or dry-cleaned. Vacuuming works best to clean dust.
3. A damp rag may be used to take out spots. A cool iron or steaming takes out wrinkles.
4. Do **NOT** use a hot iron.
5. Boys - wear white or light-colored dress shirts, dark-colored ties (not bow ties), dark trousers, dark socks and dark dress shoes.
6. NO CHEWING GUM, SUCKERS OR CANDY IN MOUTH **PLEASE!!!**
7. Boys - trim hair and be neatly shaven.
8. Caps should be worn straight and level and **not** on the back of the head. The tassel is worn on the **RIGHT** side so that it hangs just in front of the ear. The class will decide if they want to turn the tassel and when.
