WHEN I FIRST GRADUATED FROM COLLEGE, I SPENT A COUPLE OF YEARS LOOKING FOR A JOB TEACHING SOCIAL STUDIES AND PSYCHOLOGY WITH NO COACHING EXPERIENCE OR CREDITS. I PROBABLY SHOULD HAVE REALIZED THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN A PROBLEM WHEN MY SENIOR SEMINARS WERE ABOUT 20 MEN AND 3 WOMEN, ALL THAT COULD

COACH EXCEPT FOR ME. AND, I BECAME A VERY GOOD WAITRESS AND BARTENDER!

I DECIDED TO GO BACK FOR A GRAD PROGRAM THAT WOULD ALLOW ME TO TEACH SPECIAL EDUCATION. I WAS HIRED BY PRHS BECAUSE THEY NEEDED A CERTIFIED TEACHER IN THE HIGH SCHOOL AND THEY WANTED TO ADD ELECTIVES IN THE SOCIAL STUDIES. FOR THE FIRST YEAR I WORKED WITH SPECIAL NEEDS KIDS. THE FOLLOWING YEAR I STILL HAD A SPECIAL ED CASELOAD BUT BEGAN TEACHING PSYCHOLOGY TO SENIORS. LATER, AFTER A STAFF RETIREMENT, I TAUGHT CIVICS AND PSYCHOLOGY. I RETIRED FROM FULL-TIME TEACHING BUT STARTED TO WORK WITH OUR NEW ONSITE ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PART-TIME FOR SEVEN YEARS.

I MARRIED A PELICAN GRAD, A VIETNAM WAR VETERAN, AND WE RAISED OUR VIETNAMESE UNACCOMPANIED MINOR CHILDREN, 4 SIBLINGS, HERE. THEY ATTRIBUTE A LOT OF THEIR SUCCESS IN LIFE WITH THE PELICAN SCHOOLS AND GREAT TEACHERS.

I LOVED TEACHING CIVICS AND PSYCHOLOGY-ESPECIALLY DURING ELECTIONS-PURE PSYCHOLOGY! I LIKED THE ENERGY OF 7TH GRADERS AND CHALLENGE OF KEEPING THEM ON TASK BUT STILL MAKING PROGRESS. SENIORS ARE REALLY FIGURING OUT WHERE THEY ARE GOING IN LIFE AND ALWAYS MADE ME THINK AS WE KICKED AROUND IDEAS-THEY AMAZED ME! I ENJOYED WORKING WITH KIDS WHO HAD A ROUGH TIME WITH SCHOOL AND WERE IN THE ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL. SOMETIMES THEY JUST NEEDED PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS TO HELP THEM THROUGH TOUGH TIMES. I STILL ENJOY SUBBING.

I HAVE WORKED WITH THREE GREAT PRINCIPALS, EACH WITH A VERY DIFFERENT WAY OF LOOKING AT THEIR JOB AND WORKING WITH THE STAFF, BUT I ALWAYS KNEW THAT THEY CARED ABOUT KIDS. I HAVE TAUGHT WITH MANY FORMER STUDENTS. FOR AWHILE, BOTH BRIAN KORF AND DR. ED RICHARDSON WERE MY BOSSES-I LIKED TO TELL THE KIDS THAT-THEY WANTED TO KNOW HOW OLD I WAS.

Behind every child who believes in themselves, is a caring person who believed in them first.

I WAS A 5TH GRADE TEACHER FOR MY ENTIRE TEACHING CAREER AT PELICAN RAPIDS SCHOOLS. I REALLY ENJOYED THE CAMARADERIE AMONGST THE STAFF AND HOW EVERYONE ALWAYS HELPED EACH OTHER.



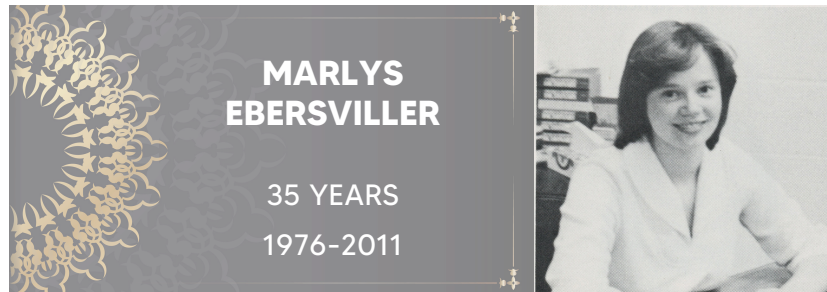

IN JUNE 1976 PRHS PRINCIPAL DON BREDELL INTERVIEWED ME FOR AN ENGLISH TEACHING POSITION. AFTER TOURING THE BUILDING AND TALKING FOR AWHILE, MR. BREDELL SAID THAT THE SUPERINTENDENT WOULD WANT TO MEET ME; MEANWHILE, HE HAD A STAFF MEMBER BUY ME ONE OF THE \$.10 POPS IN THE FACULTY LOUNGE WHILE HE TALKED WITH SUPERINTENDENT CHAUNCEY MARTIN.

WHEN I WAS RETURNED TO MR. BREDELL'S OFFICE, MR. MARTIN WAS THERE; HE ASKED ME IF I WANTED A CONTRACT. I SAID, "YES," BUT I WASN'T COMPLETELY CERTAIN THAT HE WAS OFFERING ME A JOB. HOWEVER, HE THEN SAID, "OK, I'LL GET THE CONTRACT READY." I SIGNED THE CONTRACT FOR MY FIRST TEACHING JOB A FEW MINUTES LATER. IN THOSE DAYS, THERE WERE NOT TONS OF TEACHING OPENINGS--ESPECIALLY FOR ENGLISH AND SOCIAL STUDIES TEACHERS; I HAD PREVIOUSLY DECIDED THAT I WOULD ACCEPT THE FIRST JOB OFFER THAT CAME MY WAY. WHO KNEW THAT I WOULD LOVE WORKING AND LIVING HERE AND STAY IN PELICAN RAPIDS FOR MY ENTIRE CAREER?

I REALLY ENJOYED TEACHING VARIOUS ENGLISH CLASSES AND LEVELS FROM THE FALL OF 1976 UNTIL THE SPRING OF 1985. LOVED BEING AN ENGLISH TEACHER--I THINK THE 7TH GRADE ENGLISH CLASSES WERE MY FAVORITE. I ALSO DIRECTED SEVERAL ALL-SCHOOL PLAYS AND COACHED SPEECH FOR A SEASON; LATER I SERVED AS ADVISOR FOR THE SCHOOL YEARBOOK FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS.

SUSPECTING THAT DECLINING ENROLLMENT WOULD BE THREATENING MY POSITION IN THE NOT-SO-DISTANT FUTURE, I ASKED FOR A LEAVE OF ABSENCE IN 1981-82 TO ATTEND MOORHEAD STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE I COMPLETED THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A MASTER'S DEGREE IN COUNSELING AND GUIDANCE. FOLLOWING THAT YEAR, I RETURNED TO TEACH ENGLISH IN THE PRHS ENGLISH DEPARTMENT.

WHEN COUNSELOR CYRUS TRYGSTAD RETIRED IN 1985, MR. BREDELL, MR. KLEIN, AND THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WERE GOOD ENOUGH TO HIRE ME TO BE THE SCHOOL COUNSELOR. I REMAINED IN THAT POSITION UNTIL I RETIRED. IN ADDITION TO WORKING WITH THE PREVIOUSLY-MENTIONED ADMINISTRATORS, I APPRECIATED THE TEAM ENVIRONMENT THAT MR. GLENN MOERKE, MY NEXT PRINCIPAL, ESTABLISHED WITH MR. AL SIEGLE, MR. KLEIN, AND MYSELF. THOSE RELATIONSHIPS WERE EXTENDED TO SUBSEQUENT ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS, PRINCIPALS, AND SUPERINTENDENTS--MOST NOTABLY MR. BRIAN KORF AND MS. DEB WANER. I ALWAYS FELT SUPPORTED BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND STAFF OF DISTRICT #548.

I AM REMINDED OF SOMETHING THAT AL SIEGLE SAID AT HIS RETIREMENT PARTY: HE BEGAN WITH "YOU ASK A MAN FOR A JOB. . ." I ALSO ASKED FOR A JOB AND, IN ADDITION, I GAINED A RICH AND FULL LIFE.

IT WAS MY GREAT HONOR TO SERVE AS THE ACADEMIC AND PERSONAL COUNSELOR FOR THE STUDENTS OF PELICAN RAPIDS HIGH SCHOOL. BEING ALLOWED INTO THE LIVES OF MY STUDENTS WAS TRULY HUMBLING AND SACRED. IN ADDITION, IT WAS ALSO MY GREAT HONOR TO HAVE THE RELATIONSHIPS I WAS FORTUNATE ENOUGH TO HAVE WITH THE WONDERFUL STAFF AT PRHS.

THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR NAMING ME TO THE VIKING STAFF HONOR ROLL. IT WILL BE CERTAINLY BE ONE OF THE GREATEST HONORS OF MY LIFE.

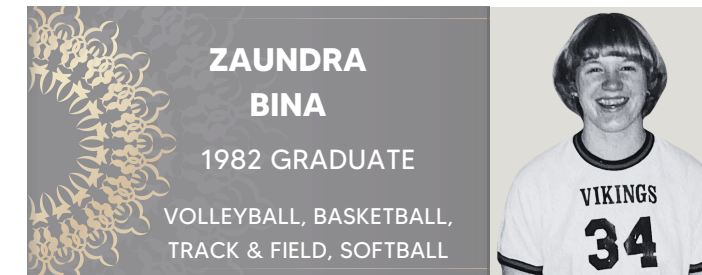

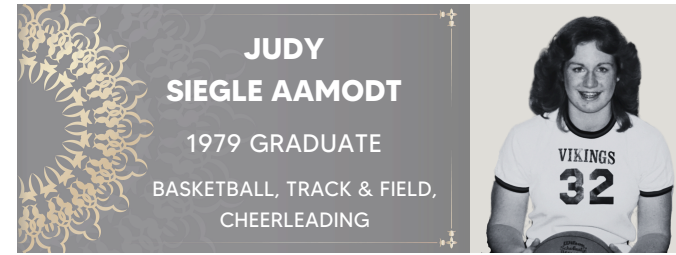
